Agenda Highlights: Many projects in the Mid-Atlantic region involve the installation of interior and exterior cold-formed steel framing in post-tensioned concrete structures. This involves careful planning and coordination by the CFS design engineer and installer to ensure that fasteners and connections do not interfere with the complex system of tendons and reinforcing in the engineered post-tensioned slabs and beams. Unfortunately, situations do arise in which the necessary fastener embedment depth for the CFS framing cannot be easily provided in the concrete. This presentation will give the CFS design and construction community a much better understanding of the benefits of and design and installation requirements for post-tensioned concrete systems. The presenter will also discuss the fastener and connection limitations that are imposed on the CFS framing and provide guidance and ideas for how to overcome these obstacles.
