

**Agenda Highlights:** More and more, code requirements and more complicated and larger CFS projects are causing CFS

engineers to design, and contractors to utilize, adhesive anchors in situations that expansion or undercut anchors used to be acceptable. After several catastrophic adhesive anchor failures from 2006-2011. The American Concrete Institute (ACI) made a decision to use its building codes, forums, educational materials, and publications to educate the industry about proper installation of adhesive anchors beginning in 2012. In an effort to satisfy this, ACI and the CRSI worked with the Concrete Anchor Manufacturers Association and leading manufacturers of adhesive anchors to develop a comprehensive training program. The adhesive anchor installer requirements are included in the ACI 318 criteria, part of the IBC 2012 and beyond. Contractors are now required to meet the necessary training in regard to adhesive anchor installations. This presentation will discuss the ever-expanding need and use of adhesive anchors, as well as give information on the installer certification program.
