Agenda Highlights: On most jobs, the contractor has to hire their own Specialty Structural Engineer (SSE) to do the formal delegated design of the CFS framing for submittal to the A/E of Record. The SSE is tasked with, amongst other things, interpreting the contract documents and designing the CFS framing to work within the architectural intent and in accordance with the parameters provided by the Structural Engineer of Record. But, when the A/E contract documents require CFS to do something it just cannot do, or the contractor in the field performs an installation that is not in accordance with the design of the SSE, it causes project delays, cost overruns, and giant headaches for the SSE. This program shares case studies into 10 of the most commonly repeated issues seen by an SSE and provides potential solutions and suggestions on how to avoid them on future projects. Five examples will be situations called for in contract documents that are not appropriate or feasible for CFS framing, and the other five will be common errors witnessed in the field of improper installation and how to fix them. Architects, engineers and contractors will find these examples helpful to make sure projects more successful, and less stressful.
